

# Pets lesson



## VOCABULARY

pet, pets, cat, kitten, dog, puppy, bunny, snake, turtle, hamster, fish

- introduce new vocabulary with the help of flashcards, plastic toys, plush animals.



## MOVEMENT GAME

Find the pet:

1. Hide around the room or outside pet flashcards or pet toys.
2. Call out the name of one pet.  
(kids move like the pet-animal called out)
3. Find pet and repeat game (take turns hiding the pets and calling out pet to find)



## DIALOGUE

Use the picture card:

Pets dialogue card

- I have a pet cat. My pet's name is Blackie.
- Do you have a pet? What is your pet's name?



## QUESTION AND ANSWER



Teacher asks question:

- Do you have a pet?

Teacher answers own question:

- I have a pet. My pet says meow meow.
- teacher asks kids to guess what pet he or she has



## Music



- Sing song: 10 little pets; repeat
- Play song: 10 little pets; have children move around according to the verses



## Worksheets



- Use the pets lesson worksheets for extra learning materials
- Have children draw a picture of their pet, if they do not have a pet draw one they wish to have.
- Count how many pets the group of children have
